
# Crochet Triangle Head Scarf



### **Pattern Abbreviations**:

- Ch Chain
- Sk Skip
- Sc Single Crochet (inset hook, yarn over, pull through, yarn over, pull through both loops on hook.)
- Hdc Half double crochet (Yarn over, insert hook, yarn over, pull through, yarn over, pull through all 3 loops on hook.)
- Dc Double crochet (Yarn over, insert hook, yarn over, pull through, yarn over, pull through first 2 loops, yarn over, pull through last 2 loops on hook.)
- Sp Space
- St Stitch
- Sl st Slip Stitch (insert hook, yarn over, pull straight through loop on hook)
- Beg Beginning
- Turning Chain Chains made at start of the row.

## Size & Tension:

- Finished piece measures approx. 8.5" (cm) wide at base by 6.5"(cm) high.
- 3 rows = 1 inch (2.5 cm)

#### **Materials**:

- 3mm steel hook
- 1 x 50gm ball fingering weight (cotton or acrylic) yarn.

## **Pattern Notes:**

- Ch 3 at beginning of row counts as 1st Dc made
- Shell 'A': Work 3dc in same place.
- Shell 'B': Work 5dc in same place.
- Picot 'A': Slip stitch-ch2-slip stitch in same place.
- Picot 'B': Sc-ch2-sc in same place.

## Main Body of Scarf:

See pattern notes shell A and B.

#### Row 1 -

Ch3 (counts as 1st dc).

In 3rd chain from hook: Shell 'A', ch2, shell 'A'. Turn

## Row 2 -

Ch3 (counts as 1st dc).

Shell 'A' in 1st st, ch1, shell 'A'-ch2-shell 'A' in the next ch2 sp, ch1, shell 'A' in last st.

Turn

#### Row 3 -

Ch3 (counts as 1st dc).

Shell 'A' in 1st st, ch1, shell 'A' in next ch1 sp, ch1, shell 'A'-ch2-shell 'A' in the next ch2 sp, ch1, shell 'A' in next ch1 sp, ch1, shell 'A' in last st.

Turn

#### Row 4 -

Ch3 (counts as 1st dc).

Shell 'A' in 1st st, ch1, (shell 'A' in next ch1 sp, ch1) x 2, shell 'A'-ch2-shell 'A' in the next ch2 sp, ch1, (shell 'A' in next ch1 sp, ch1) x 2, shell 'A' in last st.

Turn

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#### Row 5 -

Ch3 (counts as 1st dc).

Shell 'A' in 1st st, ch1, (shell 'A' in next ch1 sp, ch1) x 3, shell 'A'-ch2-shell 'A' in the next ch2 sp, ch1, (shell 'A' in next ch1 sp, ch1) x 3, shell 'A' in last st. Turn

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#### Row 6 -

Ch3 (counts as 1st dc).

Shell 'A' in 1st st, ch1, (shell 'A' in next ch1 sp, ch1) x 4, shell 'A'-ch2-shell 'A' in the next ch2 sp, ch1, (shell 'A' in next ch1 sp, ch1) x 4, shell 'A' in last st.
Turn

#### Row 7 -

Ch3 (counts as 1st dc).

Shell 'A' in 1st st, ch1, (shell 'A' in next ch1 sp, ch1) x 5, shell 'A'-ch2-shell 'A' in the next ch2 sp, ch1, (shell 'A' in next ch1 sp, ch1) x 5, shell 'A' in last st. Turn

#### Row 8 -

Ch3 (counts as 1st dc).

Shell 'A' in 1st st, ch1, (shell 'A' in next ch1 sp, ch1) x 6, shell 'A'-ch2-shell 'A' in the next ch2 sp, ch1, (shell 'A' in next ch1 sp, ch1) x 6, shell 'A' in last st. Turn

#### Row 9 -

Ch3 (counts as 1st dc).

Shell 'A' in 1st st, ch1, (shell 'A' in next ch1 sp, ch1) x 7, shell 'A'-ch2-shell 'A' in the next ch2 sp, ch1, (shell 'A' in next ch1 sp, ch1) x 7, shell 'A' in last st. Turn

#### Row 10 -

Ch3 (counts as 1st dc).

Shell 'A' in 1st st, ch1, (shell 'A' in next ch1 sp, ch1) x 8, shell 'A'-ch2-shell 'A' in the next ch2 sp, ch1, (shell 'A' in next ch1 sp, ch1) x 8, shell 'A' in last st.
Turn

#### Ch2.

(Hdc next 3dc, sk ch1 sp) x 9, hdc in next 3 dc, 3hdc in ch2 sp, hdc in next 3 dc, (sk ch1 sp, hdc next 3 dc) x 9. Do not turn.

Continuing around edge, work an extra hdc in corner st and evenly spread a row of 38 hdc across base of scarf. Join with sl st in beg corner hdc.

## Edge:

See pattern notes picot A

#### Row 1

Ch1. (Sc next 2 st, sk1, shell 'B', sk1, sc) x 5, sc next 2 st, (Sc next 2 st, sk1, shell 'B', sk1, sc) x 5, sc in corner st.

Turn

#### Row 2

Ch1. (sc, sk1, [dc, ch1]  $\times$  4 over shell, dc in last dc of shell, sk1)  $\times$  5, 2sc, (sc, sk1, [dc, ch1]  $\times$  4 over shell, dc in last dc of shell, sk1)  $\times$  5, sc last st.

Turn

#### Row 3

Ch1. Sc, ([sk dc, picot A in next ch1 sp] x 4, sk dc, sl st in next sc) x 5 picot in next sc, sl st next sc, ([sk dc, picot A in next ch1 sp] x 4, sk dc, sl st in next sc) x 5. Break off and fasten.

## For Ties and Base Edge:

See pattern notes picot B

Ch70. With right side facing up, join with sl st in corner of scarf (in the same place as just fastened). (Picot B in sc, sk1) x 19 along base edge. Secure with sl st in corner and ch17. Break off and fasten.

Weave in loose ends ≪

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
