Crochet Infinity Cowl/Scarf



Pattern Abbreviations:

- Ch Chain
- Sk Skip
- Sc Single Crochet (inset hook, yarn over, pull through, yarn over, pull through both loops on hook.)
- Hdc Half double crochet (Yarn over, insert hook, yarn over, pull through, yarn over, pull through all 3 loops on hook.)
- Dc Double crochet (Yarn over, insert hook, yarn over, pull through, yarn over, pull through first 2 loops, yarn over, pull through last 2 loops on hook.)
- Bphdc Back-post half double crochet (Yarn over, insert hook into stitch through the back of the stitch and continue to thread hook back out through the front of the next stitch, - [ie so that your hook lies around the centre post between the 2 stitches] - yarn over, pull through both stitches, yarn over, pull through all 3 loops on hook.)
- Sp Space
- St Stitch
- Sl st Slip Stitch (insert hook, yarn over, pull straight through loop on hook)
- Beg Beginning

Size & Tension:

Finished cowl should measure approx. 40 inches (100 cm) x 6 inches (15 cm).

(Tip: It is really easy to create different looks with this pattern by increasing or decreasing rows of main body

or repeating additional edge rows to create a thicker edging!!)

Materials:

- 5mm hook
- 1 -2 x 100gm ball soft 8 ply yarn or equivalent (depending on length per ball.) Remember to always check yarn care advice before laundering finished item.

Cowl:

Ch134, join with sl st in 1st ch (be careful not to twist foundation chain).

<u>Row 1</u> -Ch2.

Sk1, dc, go back and dc in previously skipped st This will create a 'cross-over' effect. Repeat from *to* along the row. Join with sl st in beg dc. (134st/67cross-overs)

Row 2 - 10 - Repeat row 1 *Do not break off when finished.

Edge:

Ch1 Bphdc along entire row. (134st) Break off and fasten.

Re-attach yarn to other edge.

Ch1. Work a plain row of sc. Join with sl st in beg sc. (134st)

Ch1. Bphdc along row. (134st).

Break off and fasten. Weave in all loose ends≪



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
