

# Crochet Head Scarf



## **Pattern Abbreviations:**

- Ch - Chain
- Sk - Skip
- Sc - Single Crochet (*inset hook, yarn over, pull through, yarn over, pull through both loops on hook.*)
- Dc - Double crochet (*Yarn over, insert hook, yarn over, pull through, yarn over, pull through first 2 loops, yarn over, pull through last 2 loops on hook.*)
- Sp - Space
- St - Stitch
- Sl st - Slip Stitch (*insert hook, yarn over, pull straight through loop on hook*)
- Beg - Beginning
- Turning Chain - Chains made at start of the row.

## **Size & Tension:**

- Finished piece measures approx. 46" (117cm) long by 3.5" (9cm) wide.
- 3 rows of 'mesh' = 1 inch (2.5cm)

## **Materials:**

- 3mm metal hook
- 1 x 50gm ball of knitting cotton (approx. 135metres/147 yards per skein)

## **Pattern Notes:**

- Ch 4 at beginning of rows = dc + ch 1.
- Dc2tog - Work 2 dc together to make 1 st:  
*Yarn over, insert hook into 1st dc, yarn over, pull through, yarn over, pull through first 2 loops, yarn over, insert hook into 2nd dc, yarn over, pull through, yarn over, pull through first 2 loops, yarn over, pull through remaining 3 loops.*

**\*\*Note:** When completing dc2tog in row 90, insert hook into 2nd turning chain instead of '2nd dc'.

- Shell: Work 5dc in same place.

## **Scarf:**

### ***Tapered end increase-***

**Row 1** - Ch5. Dc in 5th ch from hook (should form a rough triangle). Turn

**Row 2** - Ch 4. Sk 2ch, dc-ch1-dc in next ch. Turn

**Row 3** - Ch4 and dc in same place.

Ch1, Sk ch1 sp, dc in top of next dc, ch1, sk next 2ch, dc in 2nd turning ch. Turn

**Row 4** - Ch 4. sk ch1 sp, dc in next dc.

Ch1, sk next ch1 sp, dc in next dc, ch1, sk 2ch, dc-ch1-dc in 2nd turning chain. Turn



*Your piece should look like this upon completion of row 4.*

Row 5 - Ch4, dc in same place.

\*Ch1, sk next ch1 sp, dc in next dc\*

Repeat from \*to\* 2 more times, ch1, sk 2ch, dc in 2nd turning chain. Turn

Row 6 - Ch 4. sk ch1 sp, dc in next dc.

\*Ch1, sk next ch1 sp, dc in next dc\*

Repeat from \*to\* 2 more times, ch1, sk 2ch, dc-ch1-dc in 2nd turning chain. Turn

Row 7 - Ch4, dc in same place.

\*Ch1, sk next ch1 sp, dc in next dc\*

Repeat from \*to\* 4 more times, ch1, sk 2ch, dc in 2nd turning chain. Turn

Row 8 - Ch 4. sk ch1 sp, dc in next dc.

\*Ch1, sk next ch1 sp, dc in next dc\*

Repeat from \*to\* 4 more times, ch1, sk 2ch, dc-ch1-dc in 2nd turning chain. Turn

Row 9 - Ch4, dc in same place.

\*Ch1, sk next ch1 sp, dc in next dc\*

Repeat from \*to\* 6 more times, ch1, sk 2ch, dc in 2nd turning chain. Turn

Row 10 - Ch 4. sk ch1 sp, dc in next dc.

\*Ch1, sk next ch1 sp, dc in next dc\*

Repeat from \*to\* 6 more times, ch1, sk 2ch, dc-ch1-dc in 2nd turning chain. Turn

Row 11 - Ch4, dc in same place.

\*Ch1, sk next ch1 sp, dc in next dc\*

Repeat from \*to\* 8 more times, ch1, sk 2ch, dc in 2nd turning chain.

You should now have 11 'boxes'.

Turn



*Piece should look like this upon completion of row 11.*

**Main body-**

Row 12 - 89

Ch 4. sk ch1 sp, dc in next dc.

\*Ch1, sk next ch1 sp, dc in next dc\*

Repeat from \*to\* 8 more times, ch1, sk 2ch, dc in 2nd turning chain. Turn

***Tapered end decrease-***

Row 90 - Ch 4. sk ch1 sp, dc in next dc.

\*Ch1, sk next ch1 sp, dc in next dc\*

Repeat from \*to\* 7 more times, ch1, sk next ch1 sp, dc2tog (*see patterns notes*). Turn

Row 91 - Ch3, sk next ch1 sp, dc in next dc.

\*Ch1, sk next ch1 sp, dc in next dc\*

Repeat from \*to\* 7 more times, ch1, sk 2ch, dc in 2nd turning chain. Turn

Row 92 - Ch 4. sk ch1 sp, dc in next dc.

\*Ch1, sk next ch1 sp, dc in next dc\*

Repeat from \*to\* 5 more times, ch1, sk next ch1 sp, dc2tog. Turn

Row 93 - Ch3, sk next ch1 sp, dc in next dc.

\*Ch1, sk next ch1 sp, dc in next dc\*

Repeat from \*to\* 5 more times, ch1, sk 2ch, dc in 2nd turning chain. Turn

Row 94 - Ch 4. sk ch1 sp, dc in next dc.

\*Ch1, sk next ch1 sp, dc in next dc\*

Repeat from \*to\* 3 more times, ch1, sk next ch1 sp, dc2tog. Turn

Row 95 - Ch3, sk next ch1 sp, dc in next dc.

\*Ch1, sk next ch1 sp, dc in next dc\*

Repeat from \*to\* 3 more times, ch1, sk 2ch, dc in 2nd turning chain. Turn

Row 96 - Ch 4. sk ch1 sp, dc in next dc.

\*Ch1, sk next ch1 sp, dc in next dc\*

Repeat from \*to\* 1 more time, ch1, sk next ch1 sp, dc2tog. Turn

Row 97 - Ch3, sk next ch1 sp, dc in next dc.

\*Ch1, sk next ch1 sp, dc in next dc\*

Repeat from \*to\* 1 more time, ch1, sk 2ch, dc in 2nd turning chain. Turn

Row 98 - Ch 4. sk ch1 sp, dc in next dc.

Ch1, sk next ch1 sp, dc2tog. Turn

Row 99 - Ch3, sk next ch1 sp, dc in next dc.

Ch1, sk 2ch, dc in 2nd turning chain. Turn

Row 100 - Ch3, sk ch1 sp, dc in last dc. Don't break off yarn.

Break off and fasten. Weave in loose ends ☞



*Finished scarf*



*Piece should look like this upon completion of row 100.*

### **Scalloped Edge**

Turn piece so that diagonal edge is facing upward.

Ch1. \*sc in ch1 sp, shell in the next ch1 sp.\*

Repeat from \*to\* along the entire edge of piece.

Finish with a sl st in beg sc.
